- Rain gives people and animals water to drink.

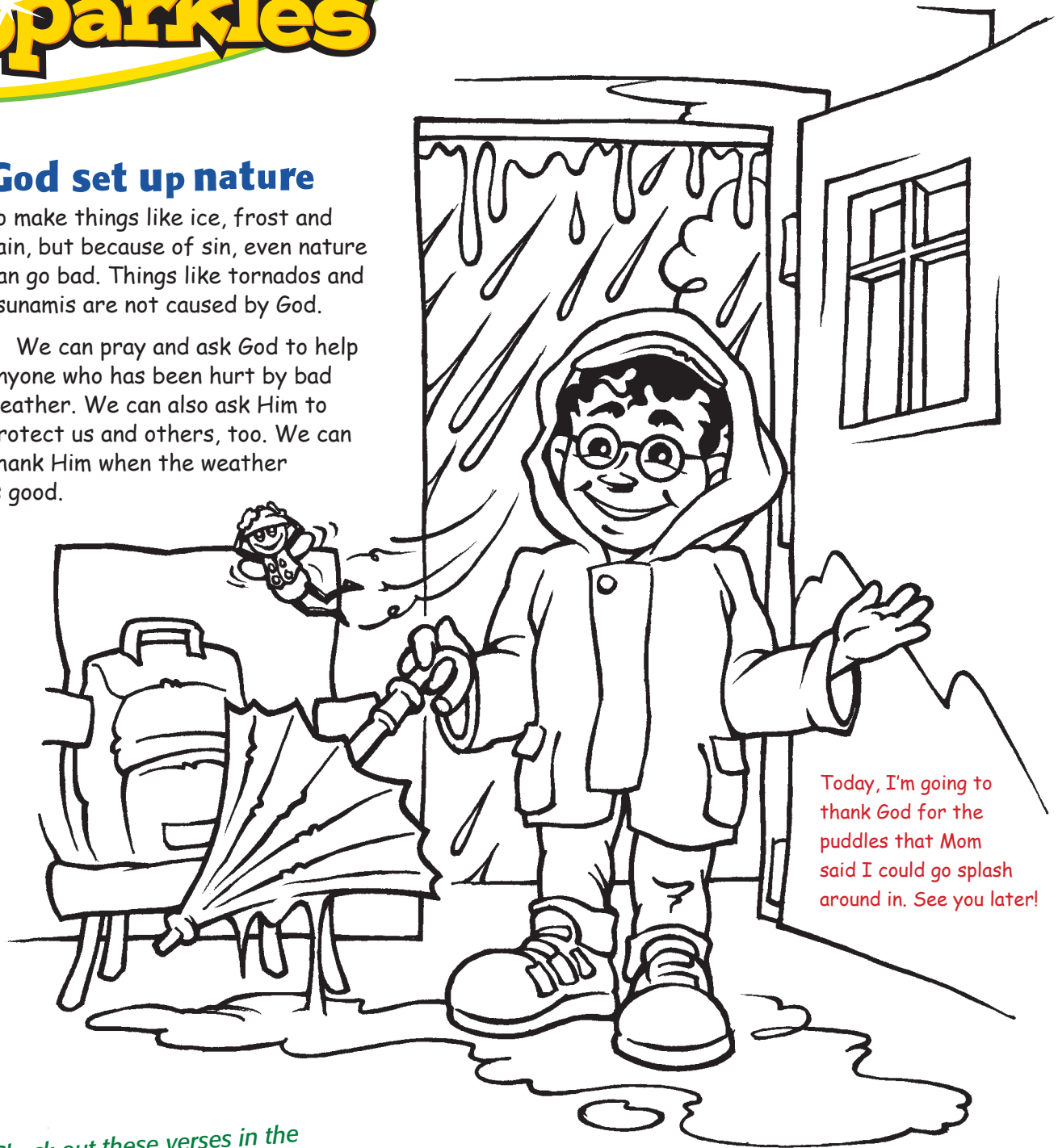




## God set up nature
